

I Nathaniel Abbot, of Lincoln in the County of
Middlesex, & Commonwealth of Massachusetts, aged
seventy nine years, testify & say, that I was a
Soldier in the United States Service, as a Private or
Corporal in the Company commanded by Capt Thomas Turner
of Col Henry Jacksons Regt ^{of the Continental Army} for the period of
three years, commencing the nineteenth day of
August 1777, that I received, at the expiration
of my service, a written discharge signed by
Col Henry Jackson, which was soon after de-
stroyed, & that, at the time I entered the service
I resided at said Lincoln, where I have
ever since resided. I further testify & say
that I make this Declaration for the purpose
of obtaining the benefit of the Resolve of the
General Court of the Commonwealth of Massa-
chusetts, passed on the twenty seventh day of
March. 1833
