I *Samuel Adams* of *Bowdoin* in the County of *Lincoln* and State of Maine, aged *Seventy six* years, do, upon oath declare, in order to obtain the benefit of a Resolve of the Legislature of Maine, passed March 17, 1835, entitled a "Resolve in favor of certain Officers and Soldiers of the Revolutionary War, and the Widows of the deceased Officers and Soldiers," that I enlisted *as a private in the year 1777* for *three years into Capt White's company and Colo Francis's regt of the Mep. line in the Revolutionary* and was discharged at *West Point in the year 1780* having served the full period of *three years* and received an *honourable discharge*, for which *Service I am upon the U. States pension roll of the Maine Agency.*

I do further on oath declare that at the time of my said enlistment, I was an inhabitant of *Westport in the then district of Maine* and was on the 17th day of March, 1835, have been ever since, and am now an inhabitant of the State of Maine, residing in *Bowdoin* aforesaid, where I have resided for *Several* years past. That neither I, nor any one claiming under me, has ever received a grant of Land, or money in lieu thereof, from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, for my said service, or any other service during the Revolutionary War, and that I am justly entitled to the benefit of said Resolve.

I do further declare that in the year 1776 I was in Capt Leonard's company Colo Mitchell's Regiment for seven months. Also in the fall of the year 1776 was three months in Capt Stanswood's company Colo Briggs's regt. for which service I was honourably discharged.

And my said Attorney is hereby authorized and empowered upon the receipt of said certificate, for me and in my name, to execute such receipt or acknowledgment therefor, as I might, were I personally present.

VOSE, of AUGUSTA, in the County of Kennebec, my Attorney irrevocable, for me and in my name and stead to bargain for, sell, dispose of and transfer to any person, and upon such terms as he may think best, the Certificate which he may obtain for me of the Land Agent, and of my right and interest in and to the Land to which I shall be entitled in virtue thereof and of the Resolve aforesaid. And in case my said Attorney shall not sell or transfer such certificate before the Land shall be surveyed and laid out into lots as provided in said Resolve, and ready for selection and conveyance, I further hereby authorize and empower my said Attorney to represent me before the Land Agent, and for me and in my stead to select and make choice of the lot of Land to which I am entitled, and to receive from the Land Agent a Deed and Conveyance thereof to me in fee, and after having obtained such Deed and Conveyance, I hereby further authorize and empower my said Attorney to sell and dispose of such lot of Land on such terms and conditions as he may think proper, and for me and in my name and stead to make, execute and deliver a Deed and Conveyance thereof to the purchaser, as fully as I could do if present.
